What is Bike Generation?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bike Generation engages children at Lockleaze Adventure Playground with cycling activities. (age range 6yrs – 13yrs) • We use fun games to develop cycling skills and introduce children to special cycling activities, such as BMX and mountain biking. • We show children how to maintain their bikes and start to build their knowledge about bicycle mechanics.
Outline of the role	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Offer individual attention to help a child with tasks such as learning to ride, fixing a broken bike or learning game rules. • Keep children focused during games, clarify rules and help mediate disputes. • Keep the Adventure Playground bikes in good working order.
Skills needed (either or both)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic bike maintenance skills. • Experience of working with young people.
